

Travel Data Saver 30 day and daily mobile internet bundles

If you're an Orange pay monthly customer you can buy a daily or 30-day bundle to use GPRS and 3G mobile internet on your phone in Armenia, Australia, Columbia, Croatia, Ecuador, Israel, Mexico, Russia, Turkey and USA .

You'll need a compatible phone or mobile broadband device that is set up for roaming. You'll need to pass our credit check to set up your phone - call Orange Customer Services on 150 for free from your Orange phone to get set up and order your bundle. Remember, roaming is an Additional Service.

If you choose the daily bundle for £6 per day, you'll have 30 MB of data per day. We'll apply the bundle to your account within 24 hours of your order but the daily bundle will only activate when you start using the data within a country covered by this bundle. The bundle will stay on your account until you tell us to stop it by calling 150 from your Orange phone. Remember, you'll only be charged £6 on the days you use data whilst roaming abroad and your 30 MB of data will last until you reach your data limit or midnight on those days, whichever comes first. Once the bundle is cancelled, any unused data will be lost.

If you choose a 30 day bundle, you can choose between a £20 bundle giving you 30MB of data or a £75 bundle for 150MB of data or £175 bundle for 500MB of data for 30 days. The 30 day bundle will be applied to your account within 24 hours from when you order it and it will activate from that time, but you can ask for it to be activated up to 28 days in advance. The bundle lasts for a fixed 30 day period from activation and can't be cancelled. To be clear, the 30 day bundle doesn't activate when you start using data abroad but from when we've applied it to your account. If you don't use your allowance of data within 30 days, you'll lose it.

You can only have one of our Travel Data Saver bundles on your account at any one time.

Each session of data roaming usage is rounded up to the nearest byte and once you've used your inclusive allowance, you'll be charged £8 per MB consumed for any additional internet use from your phone or mobile broadband device in the countries listed above.

If your service plan is inclusive of roaming data charges, the allowance under your bundle will be used first. The bundle does not include download charges for example, charges for downloading ringtones or games. Charges incurred whilst roaming may be billed several months in arrears. The balance of the allowance shown on your monthly invoice may not therefore be accurate as certain charges for previous usage may not have been processed by Orange at that time. Remember, mobile internet browsing is not to be used for other activities (e.g. using your phone handset as a modem (except where you have a tethering bundle), non-Orange internet based streaming services, voice or video over the internet, instant messaging, peer to peer file sharing).
